# Live in Düsseldorf

It is a mandatory requirement to have a register apartment (Anmeldung) to live in Germany legally for more than three months and also it is necessary for bureaucratic processes like opening a bank account, getting a German tax ID, and applying for a residence permit if needed.

We have some services through which we can support you in your search for an accommodation.

Note: It's generally recommended to avoid prepaying unless it's through a trusted platform or source. While it can secure better prices or reservations, you risk losing money if the booking isn't honored.
